The 50 things app can benefit children in the setting and home learning environment. In addition to supporting and strengthening workin with parents, the activity ideas and information make planning easy. An example of planning opportunities

Movement to music starts very young, as babies bounce and move their limbs to music, rhymes and stories. Dancing is fun and a great way to support being active and healthy. Best of all dancing and listening to music is FREE. You can dance anywhere at any time, have a garden festival, a music and movement stay and play session, disco indoors or just dance spontaneously.



By finding out and knowing your children and their families you will know if they play a musical instrument, sing, can mix music, provide cultural music and songs. Invite parents in to join your events and share the 50 Things app with them. You can also use this as an opportunity to share Peterborough's START messages and leaflets.
