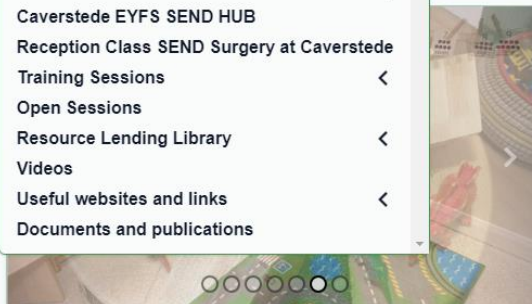

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How to use the resource lending library



In order to borrow items from Caverstede Lending Library you must agree to the following terms:

1. Schools / Settings may borrow a maximum of 6 resources at any one time plus up to 2 books - either from the childrens book selection or practitioner resource books and 1 wooden puzzle at any one time.
2. Resources are borrowed for up to a half term. The resources may be returned early and you may borrow as often as you wish. If at the end of the half term the resource is not on the waiting list it can be loaned again for a further half term if required.
3. Resources **must be returned clean, undamaged and complete.**
4. If a resource is damaged or lost the setting will be asked to either replace the resource or pay for the replacement. You will not have to pay for damage caused by normal wear and tear but we do need you to report any problems.
5. You may return the resource/s Monday to Friday between the hours of 8.00 and 16.00 during term time (a later time may be possible, please ask).

A loan agreement form must be completed by a manager/headteacher/childminder before items can be borrowed.

If the item is already being borrowed, you can reserve it for when it is returned.

- Mirrors reflect image many times over.



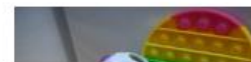

Tumble & Twirl Ball Spinner

- Cause and effect
- Push the top down and the balls spin around. The clear doors can be opened and the balls roll all over the place



Hub Sen 81

Singing Animal Keyboard

- Cause and effect
- Press the keys and the animals pop up and make animal noises



Hub Sen 107

Matching Animal Cubes – with sound

- Match the 2 halves of the same animal and it will make the animal noise



Hub Sen 106

Hello Sunshine – Hide & Seek Game

- Helps to develop gross motor skills and language skills
- Encourages instruction following
- Play hide and seek while engaging in active play
