


Our Children Previously in Care and Children in Kinship Care Arrangements offer



The DfE term 'Child Previously in Care' applies to those children who had the status of being 'in care' of a Local Authority in England and Wales but who have now left care through:

- An Adoption Order (AO) (including those adopted from 'state care' outside of England and Wales)
- A Special Guardianship Order (SGO) (also see note below*)

• A Child Arrangements Order (CAO)



We are also able to provide advice, information and support for children who are in a formal kinship care arrangement. These are kinship families with a SGO or CAO, regardless of whether the child has previously been in care. Our 'targeted' and 'bespoke' offer does not extend to those children in an informal Kinship care arrangement.

*Please note, to be considered previously in care, a child must have been in the care of a Local Authority immediately before the SGO was granted.
