(February or March)	Sensory & Physical Service (SAPS) 'Supporting children and young people with 'glue ear' / conductive hearing problems'	<p>Do you work with a child or young person who has glue ear/is waiting for grommet/wears a softband or conventional hearing aids? With the backlog in ENT services, children and young people can be waiting longer for grommet surgery with the result of an increase in children in schools and nurseries with ongoing hearing issues.</p> <p>The Sensory and Physical Support Service will be running some general awareness training about supporting children and young people who have "glue ear"/conductive hearing problems in the spring term. The date is yet to be confirmed but will be in February/March.</p> <p>Please note glue ear is a very common condition 1 in 5 pre-school children have glue ear at any one time and 8 out of 10 children will experience glue ear before the age of 10 so this is worthwhile training, particularly for those in early years settings.</p>	SENCOs/teachers/teaching assistants/early years practitioners working with children of all ages.
