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

Supervision provides an opportunity for the lead EPs to check in with ELSAs regarding their role and to offer support when need. We provide a safe and confidential space for ELSAs to reflect on and discuss their caseload, and their personal and professional responses to the role. The focus is on supporting staff in their personal and professional development and in reflecting on their practice. It is a requirement that all practicing ELSAs attend supervision.
