






## Moving & Handling training for staff working with CYP with physical disabilities

- If you need a few members of staff trained, please book onto one of the sessions at Ormiston Meadows Academy or Caverstede Nursery (for EYFS) advertised in the hub training flier. These cover physical transfers not behaviour management.

#### Children Handling and Risk Assessment Key Trainer's Certificate

- This qualification would allow schools or academy trusts to deliver their own in-house training.
- Quality Assured by RoSPA Qualifications as a Customised Award Advanced Level 4
- This is a 4-day theory and practical course delivered by Edge Services at Ormiston Meadows Academy from 3-6th December 2024.
- There will be a maximum of 10 places on the course and the cost will be shared between the
  participants. If we can fill 6 places, the cost per participant will be £806+ VAT. In comparison,
  the cost of the public course held in Birmingham is £905 + VAT per participant, without taking
  into account travel costs.
- If we can fill more places, then the cost per head will be lower.

#### Specialist seating for children with physical disabilities

- The scheme through which most specialist school seating is funded by SENI Services is up and running. The practical aspects of this (assessing, ordering, fitting etc.) will be organised by the CYP's Occupational Therapist. What is new this term, is that there will be a **Memorandum of Understanding** for schools to sign which commits you to looking after the equipment whilst it is in your care.
- The process whereby specialist seating equipment which is no longer needed can be audited and returned to the NRS warehouse should be starting later this month, but will take some time to reach everywhere. The aim is to have unused equipment held centrally, so it can be reissued, rather than it sitting in school cupboards.
