**Aspiration**; Have a paid job working in gaming

**Need**; Profound hearing impairment affecting communication

#### Outcome;

• By the end of ......Abigail will be able to use a bus pass/ Oyster Card and know how to plan a route to a familiar destination e.g. home

#### **Provision**

- Employability Curriculum focusing on work skills.
- Work experience for 1 day per week in Fazer Gaming Company with BSL signer support
- Independent travel training programme with BSL signer support 12 week course
